# HOW DO I KNOW THAT I AM SAVED?



#### IS IT POSSIBLE TO HAVE THE ASSURANCE OF SALVATION?

Very definitely and absolutely essential to be assured, God desires this and therefore has given us scripture to confirm this assurance.

#### 1 JOHN 5:12-13

"He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

John says that he has written these things (all the text of 1 John prior to this statement) so that we may know that we have eternal life. In examining the things John wrote we see that he gives us 10 assurances that we can measure our lives against. We call these the 10 tests of salvation.

1. Walk in the light

2. Keeping His Commandments

3. Loving Your Brother

4. Not Loving the World

5. The Apostles doctrine

6. Doing what is righteous

7. Prepare for the resurrection

8. Laying your life down for the brethren 1 John 3:10-19 (Gal 5:13, Eph 4:1-7, 11-16 Phi 2:2-4,)

9. The ability to discern

10. Have faith in God

1 John 2:3-6 (Mat 22:36-40, Joh 14:15, 21, 15:9-16, 2 Joh 1:6)

1 John 2:15–17 (Luk 16:13, Luk 8:14, 21:34–36)

Many people think because they prayed a sinners prayer or go to church they are automatically true believers in Jesus. The scripture teaches that this is not the case as we have seen in the list from 1 John above.


Matthew 7:21-27 teaches us that many will come on that day professing to know the Lord and even had done signs and wonders in His name and He declares that He never knew them.

As we examine our lives based on these 10 tests we will know exactly where we stand regarding our salvation. It is critical that we know we are truly saved and with this assurance we will live securely with our identity firmly rooted in Christ.

- We are forgiven Colossians 1:13, 2:141
- We are new creatures 2 Corinthians 5:171
- We are saints Ephesians 2:191
- We are loved Romans 8:37-391
- We are blessed Ephesians 1:131
- We are more than conquerors Romans 8:371
- We are complete in Christ Colossians 2:10

There are many other scriptures declaring who we are in Christ and we need to walk in this status that was secured by Jesus - Philippians 3:12-15
