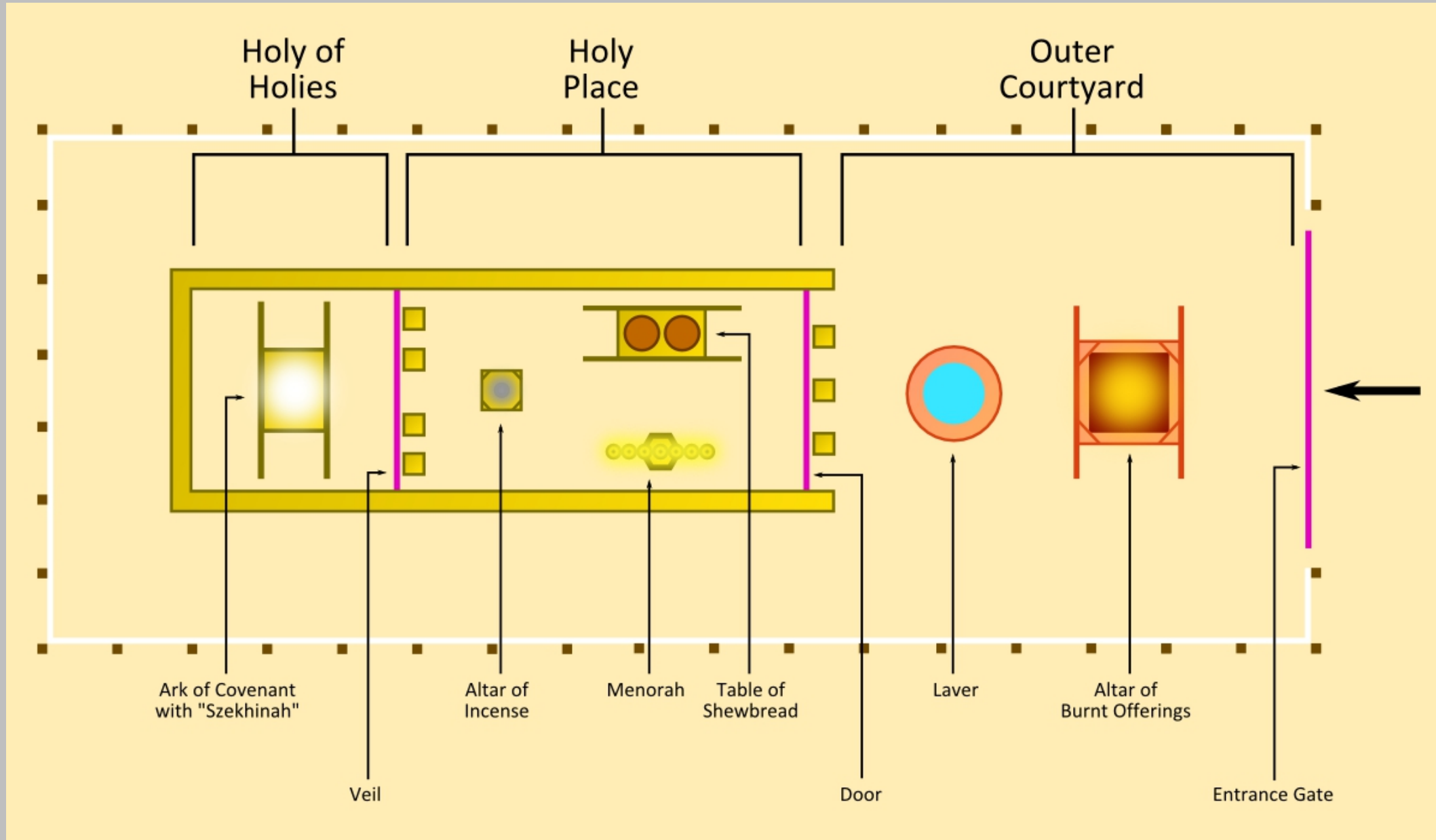

From H7931; a residence (including a shepherd's hut, the lair of animals, figuratively the grave; also the Temple); specifically the Tabernacle (properly its wooden walls): - **dwelleth, dwelling (place), habitation, tabernacle, tent.**



- Built by the children of Israel under the supervision of Moses, around 1450 B.C.
- Portable construction, transported by the Levites through the 40 years in the desert wilderness.

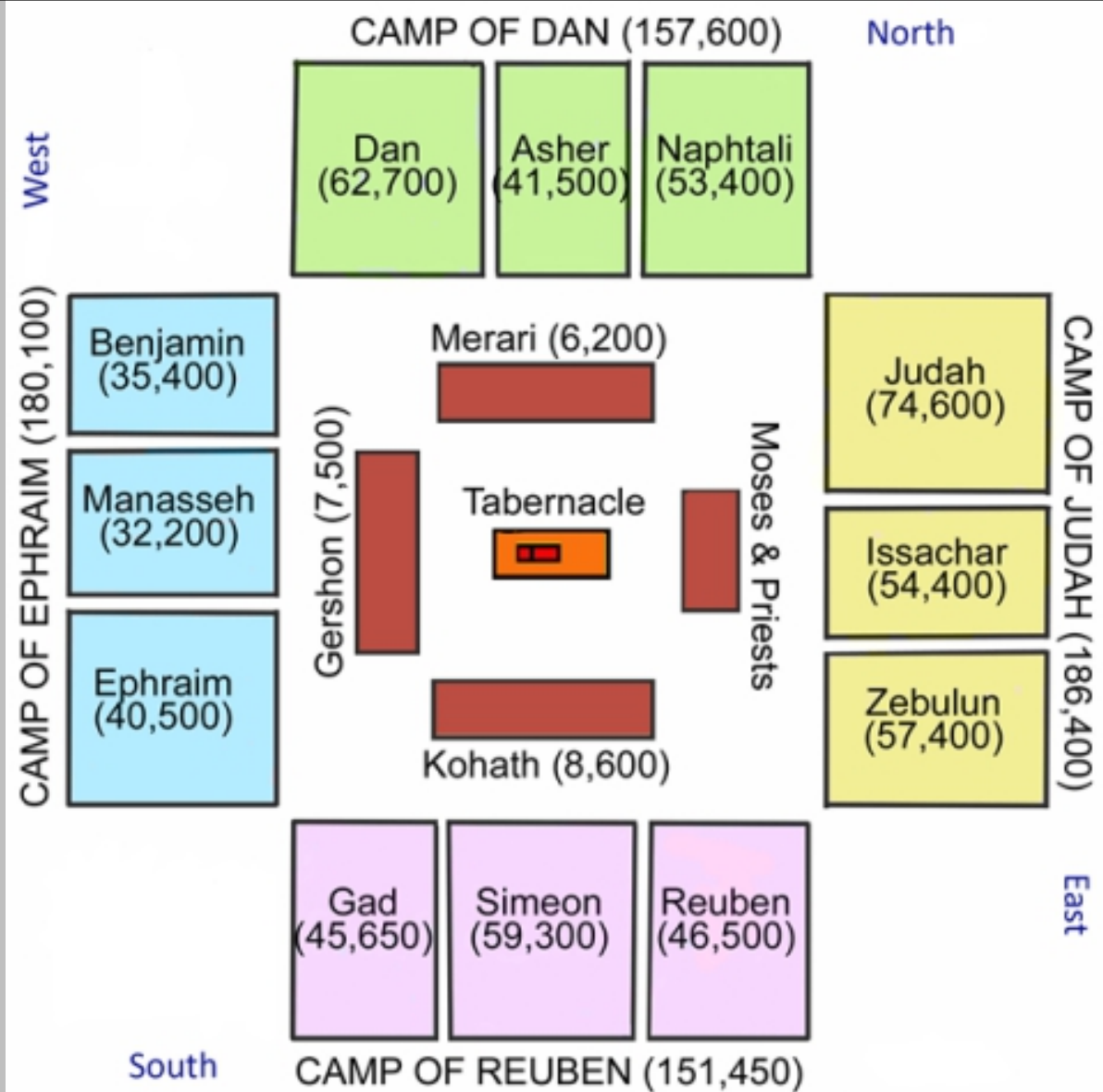

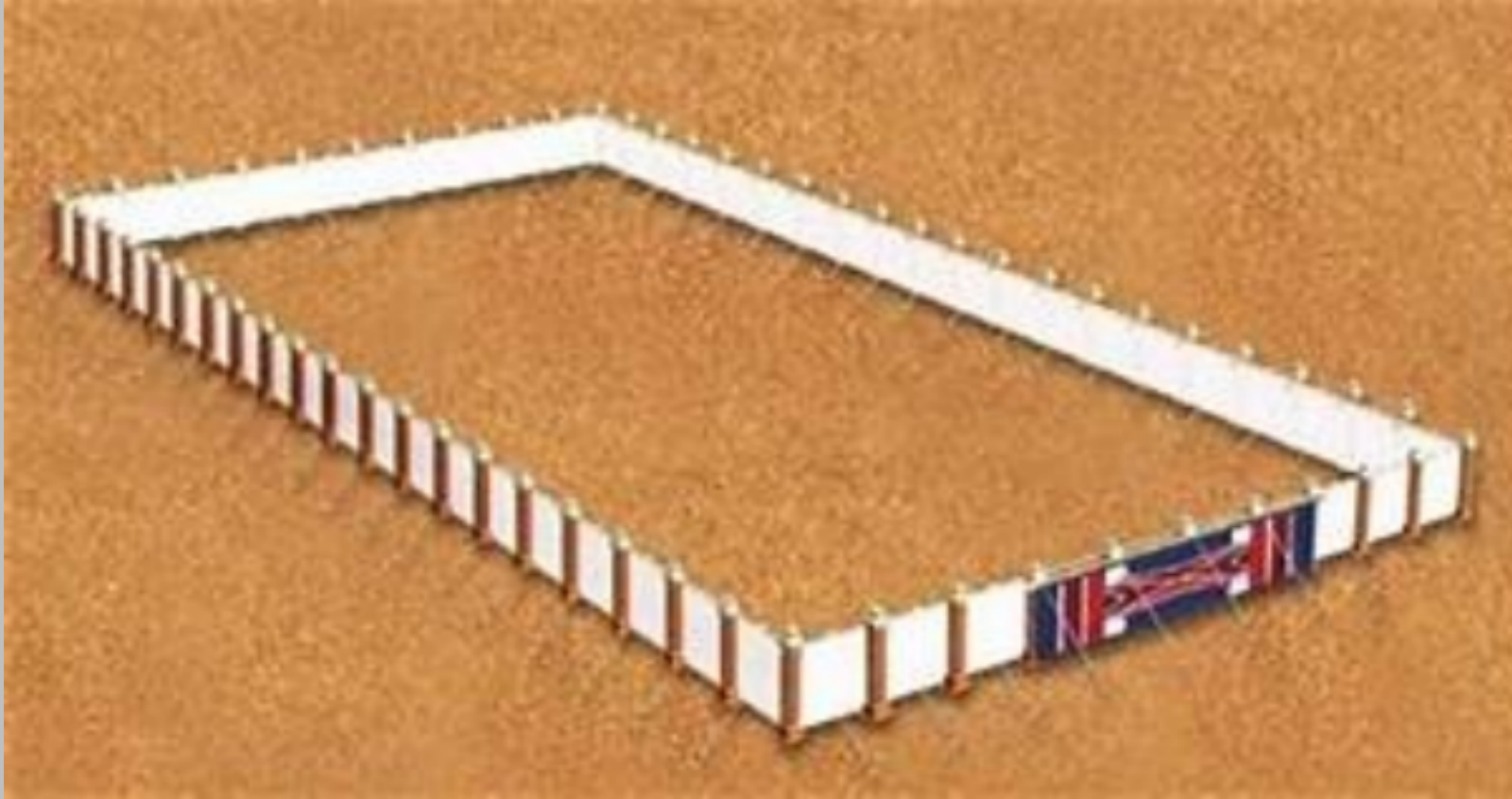

Red.

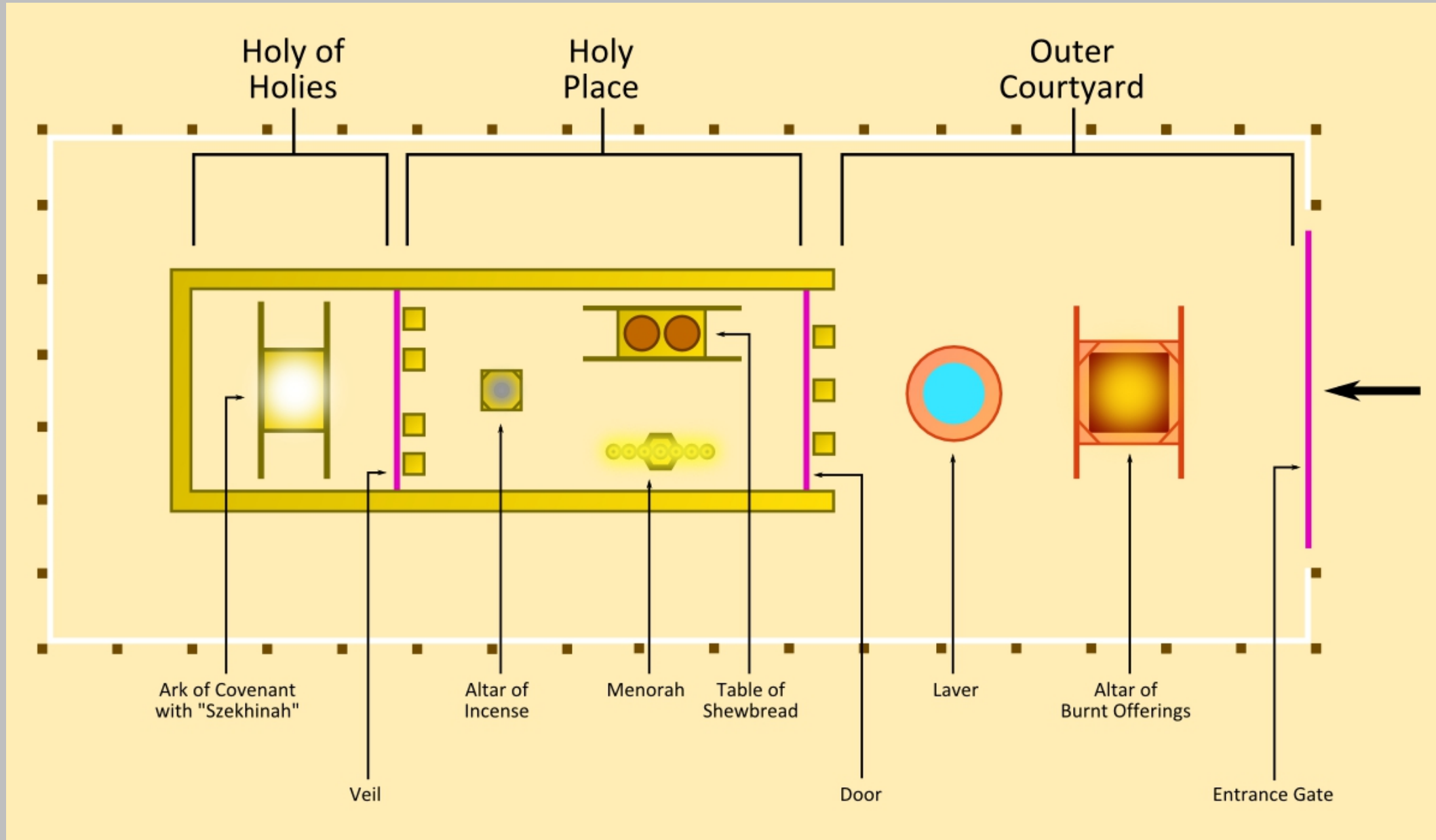


4 gospels that reveal Christ

1.4m high
2.3m square

Trespass Offering: (*Leviticus 5:1-17; 7:1-10*)

Jesus has forgiven us - (Mathew 18:15)

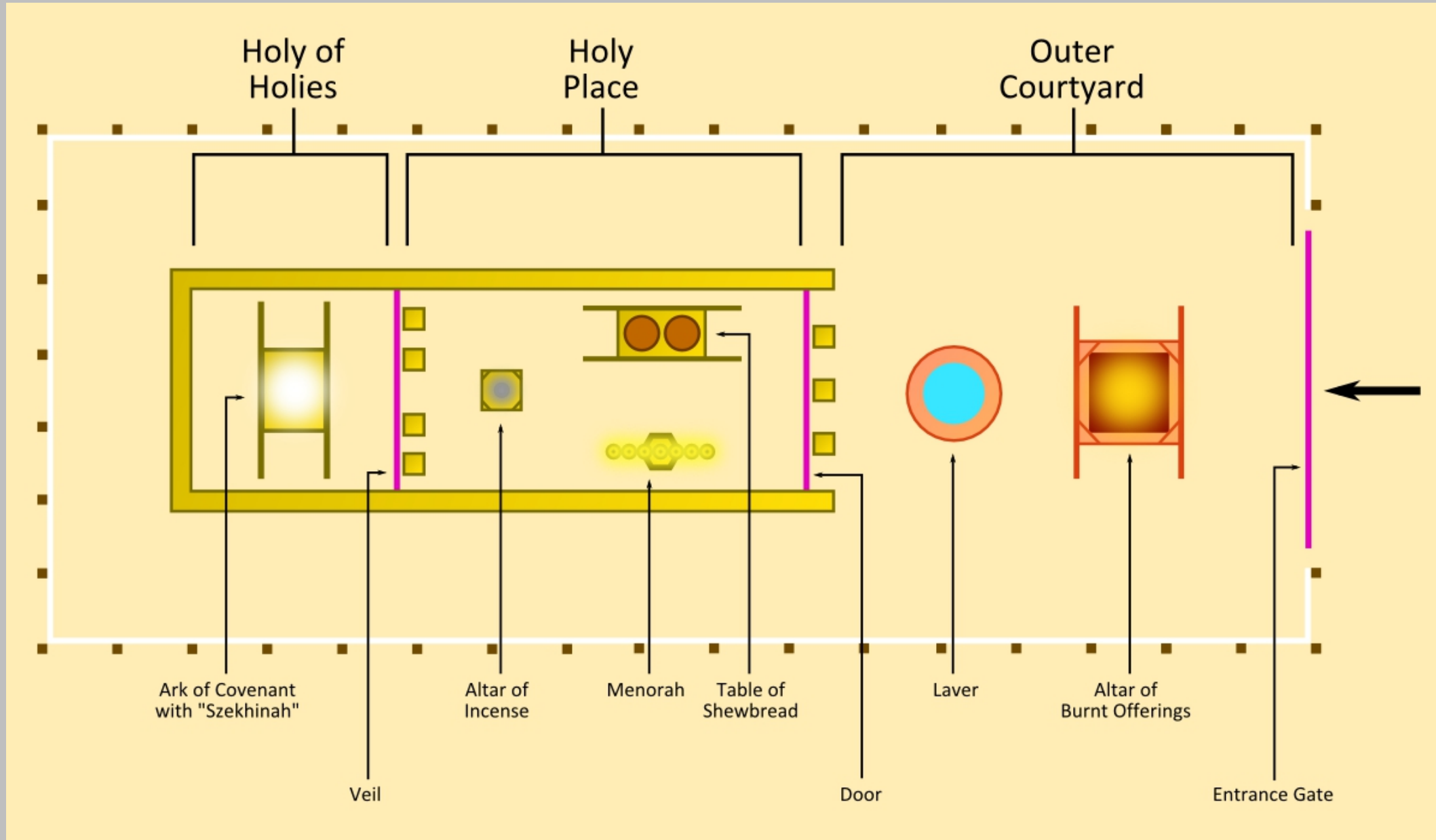
Peace Offering: (*Leviticus 3:1-17; 7:11-36*)

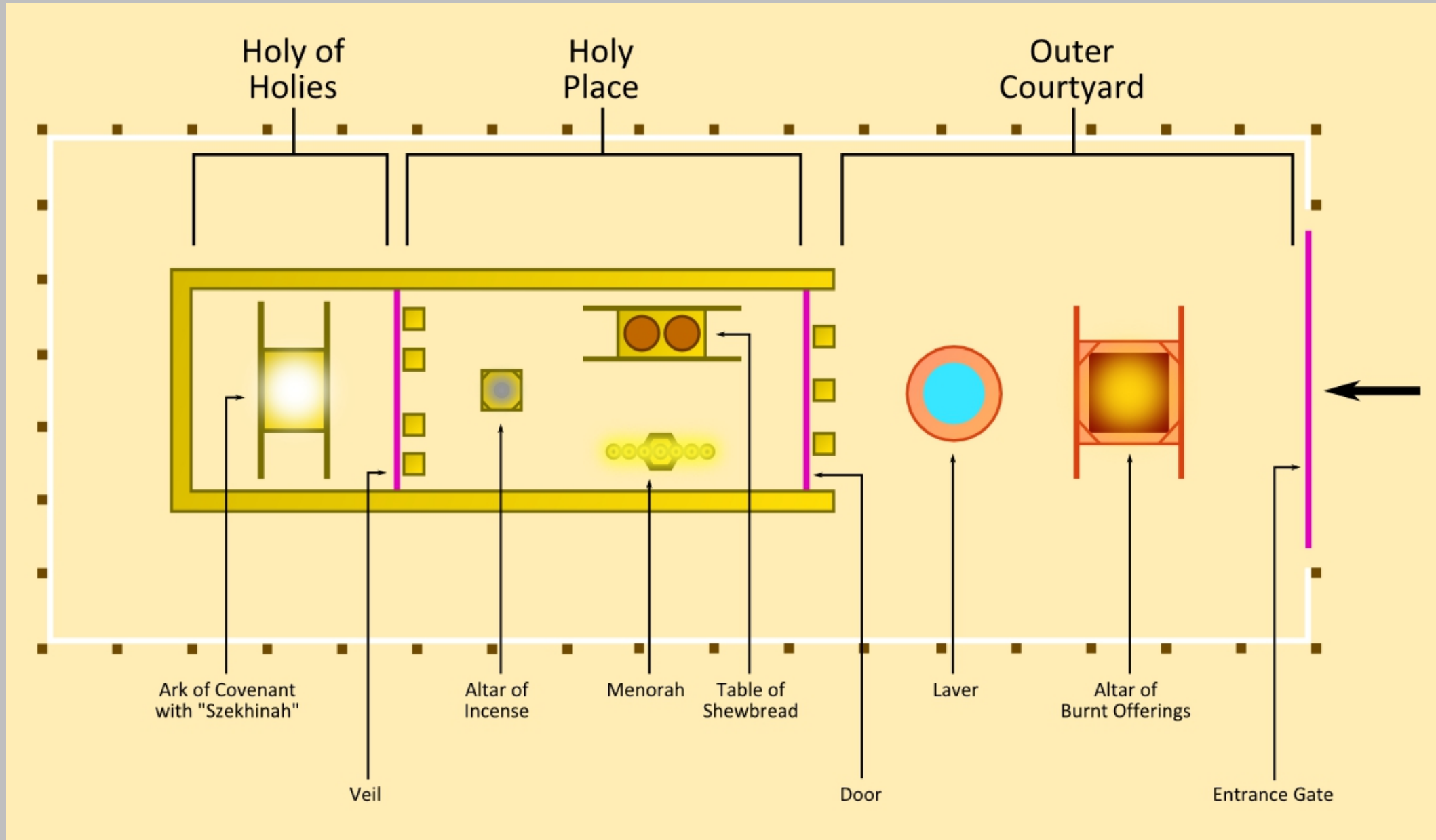

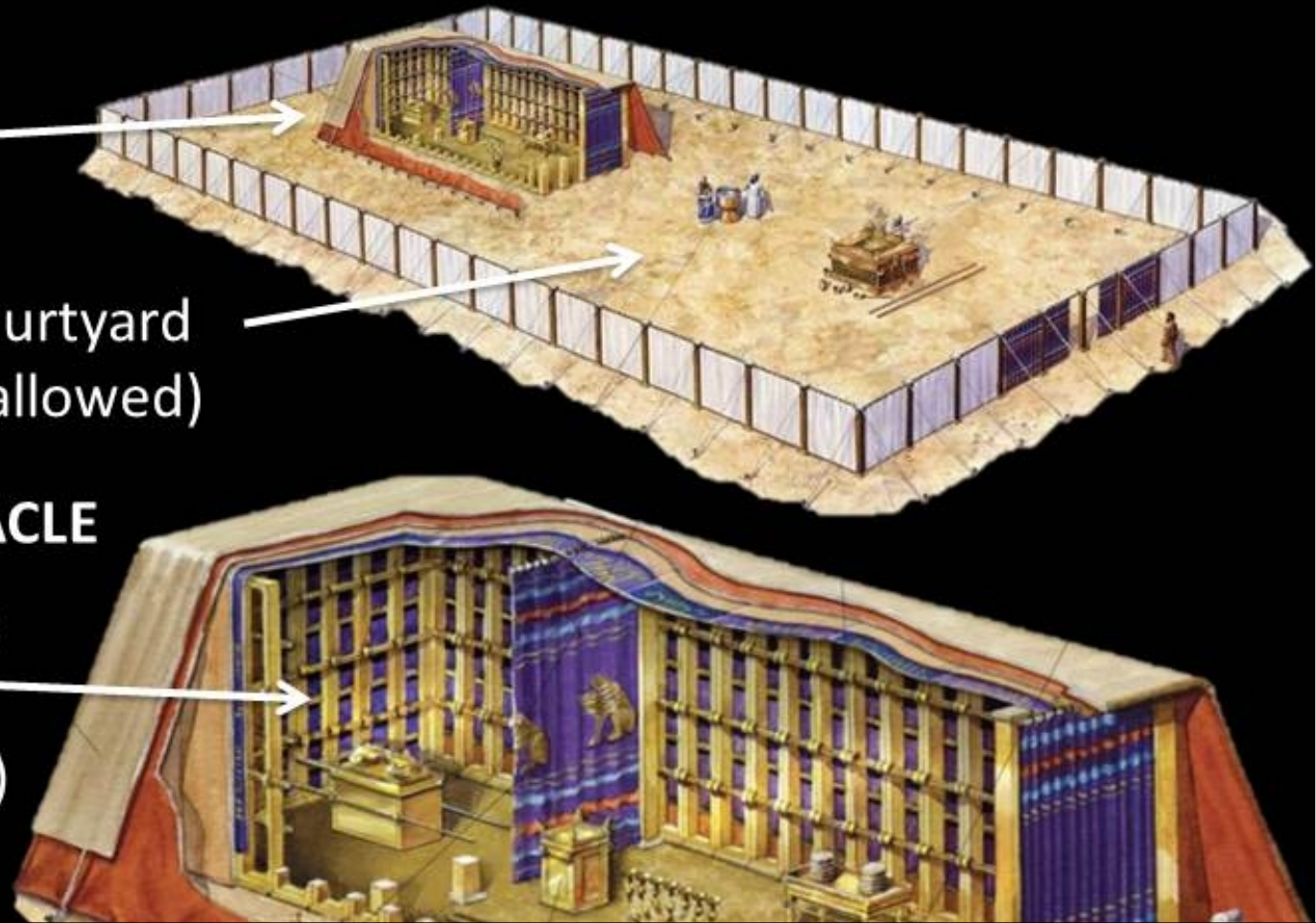
(also known as the Sanctuary or Tent of Meeting)

(people allowed)

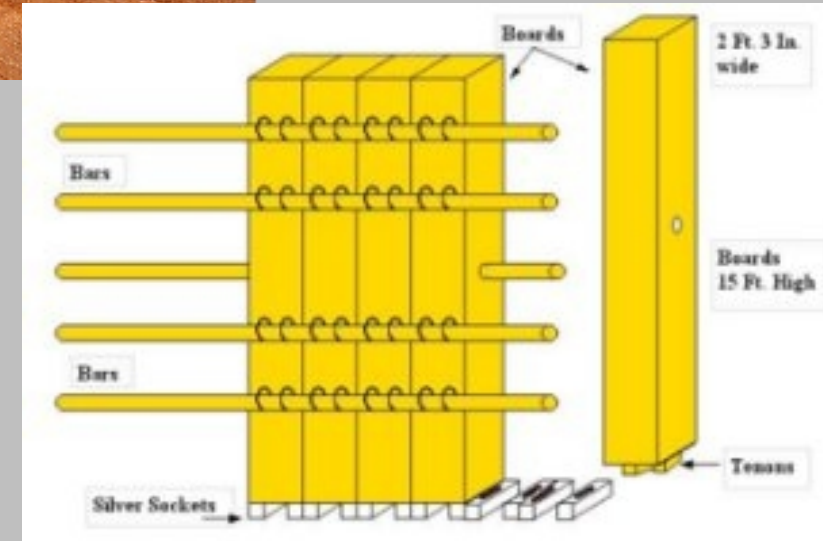
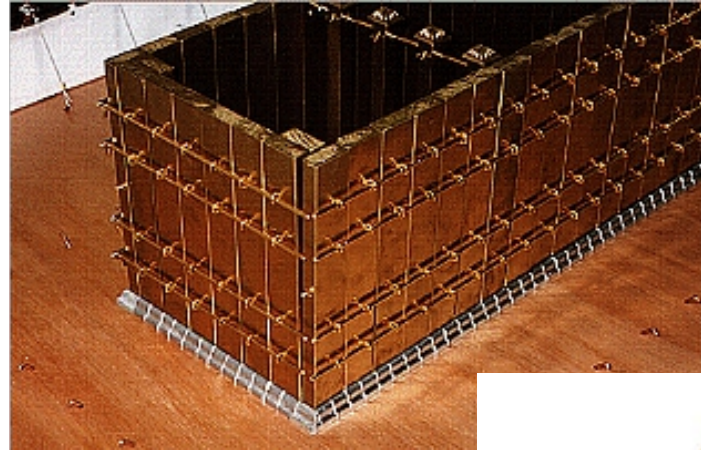
INSIDE THE TABERNACLE

The Sanctuary Boards

Exodus 26:1-37



Wooden boards overlaid with gold resting in silver bases - (Exodus 26:15-30)

Held together by 5 wooden bars overlaid with gold - (Exodus 26:15-30)

4 Bars went through rings on the boards, the middle bar went through the boards – (Ephesians 4: 1-16)

The door to the sanctuary was made of the same colors as the Outer court door

It was held up by 5 golden pillars overlaid with gold.

We are Gods building - (1 Corinthians 3:9, Ephesians 2:19-22)

The Sanctuary Coverings

Exodus 26:1-37

Outer Covering (*Exodus 26:14*)

Made from badger skins – Tough, weather proof

Did not look appealing - (Isaiah 53:1-3)

The treasure is in the earthen vessel - (II Corinthians 4:7)

God gave us His only Son - (Phillipians 2:5-8)

Covering of Rams' Skin Dyed Red (*Exodus 26:14*)

Jesus redeemed us with His own blood - (I Peter 1:18-19)

Woven Goats' Hair Covering (*Exodus 26:7-13*)

One goat sacrificed and the blood taken into the Holy of Holies by the High Priest – (Hebrews 9:22)

The other goat had the sin of the people transferred onto it and it was sent into the wilderness - (II Corinthians 5:21, Psalm 103:12)

God forgives and forgets – (Hebrews 8:12)

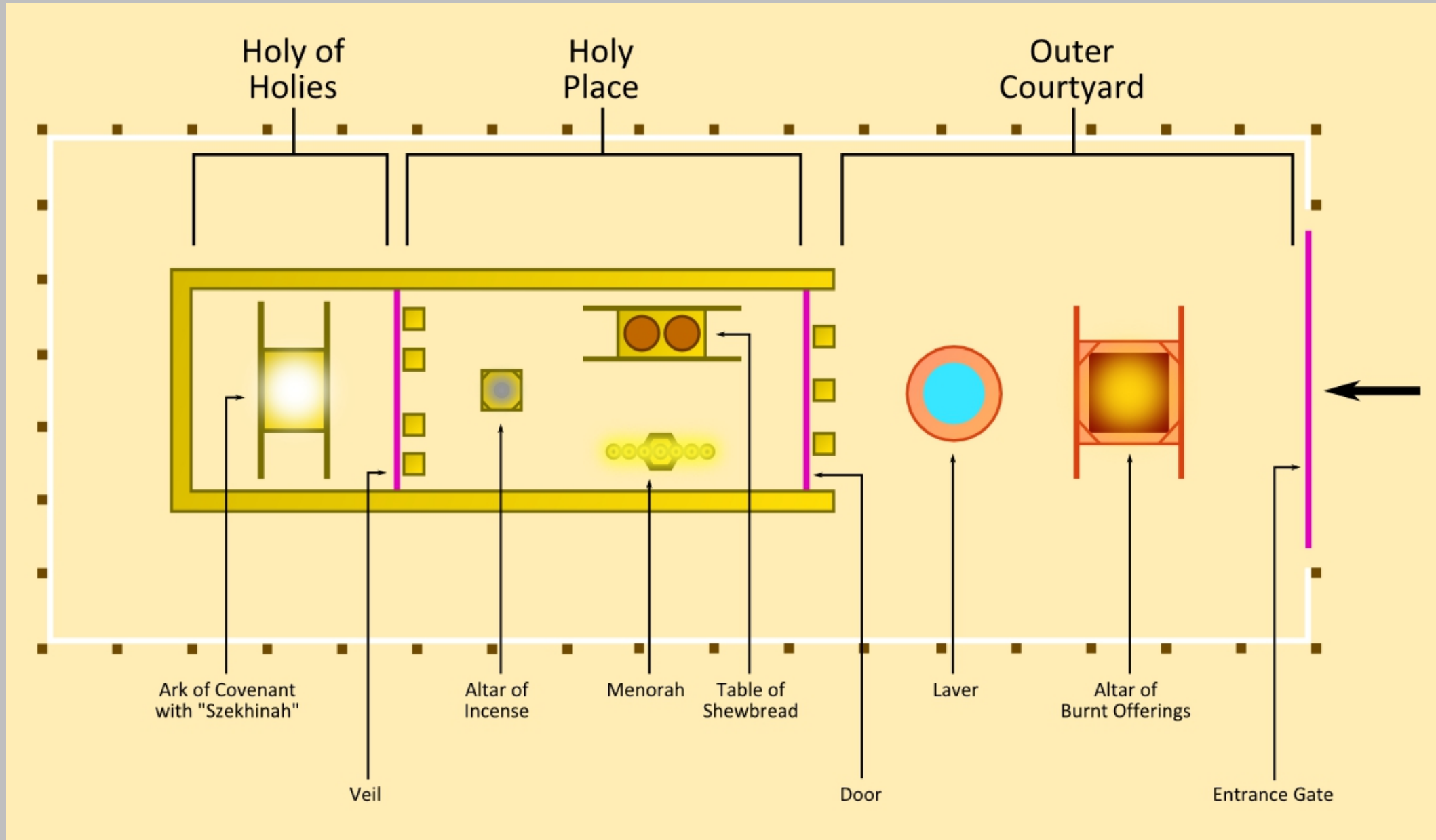
Cherubim Embroidered Covering (*Exodus 26:1-6*)

The throne room is surrounded by angels - (Revelation 5:10-14)

Jesus is head over all things - (Ephesians 1:22)

The Holy Place

The Lampstand: (*Exodus 25:31-39*)

Made from 1 solid piece of gold having 7 candlesticks which burned continuously.

The middle candlestick was beaten out first then each side – Jew and Gentile

There was no natural light in the room

Jesus is the light – (John 1:4)

Fellowship – (1 John 1:5-7)



The Showbread Table: (*Exodus 25:23-30*)

Wood overlaid with Gold, containing 12 loaves of unleavened bread

The Bread of life - (John 6:33)

No leaven(Sin)

Speaks of the breaking of bread – (1 Corinthians 11:23-33)



The Golden Incense Altar. (*Exodus 30:1-10*)

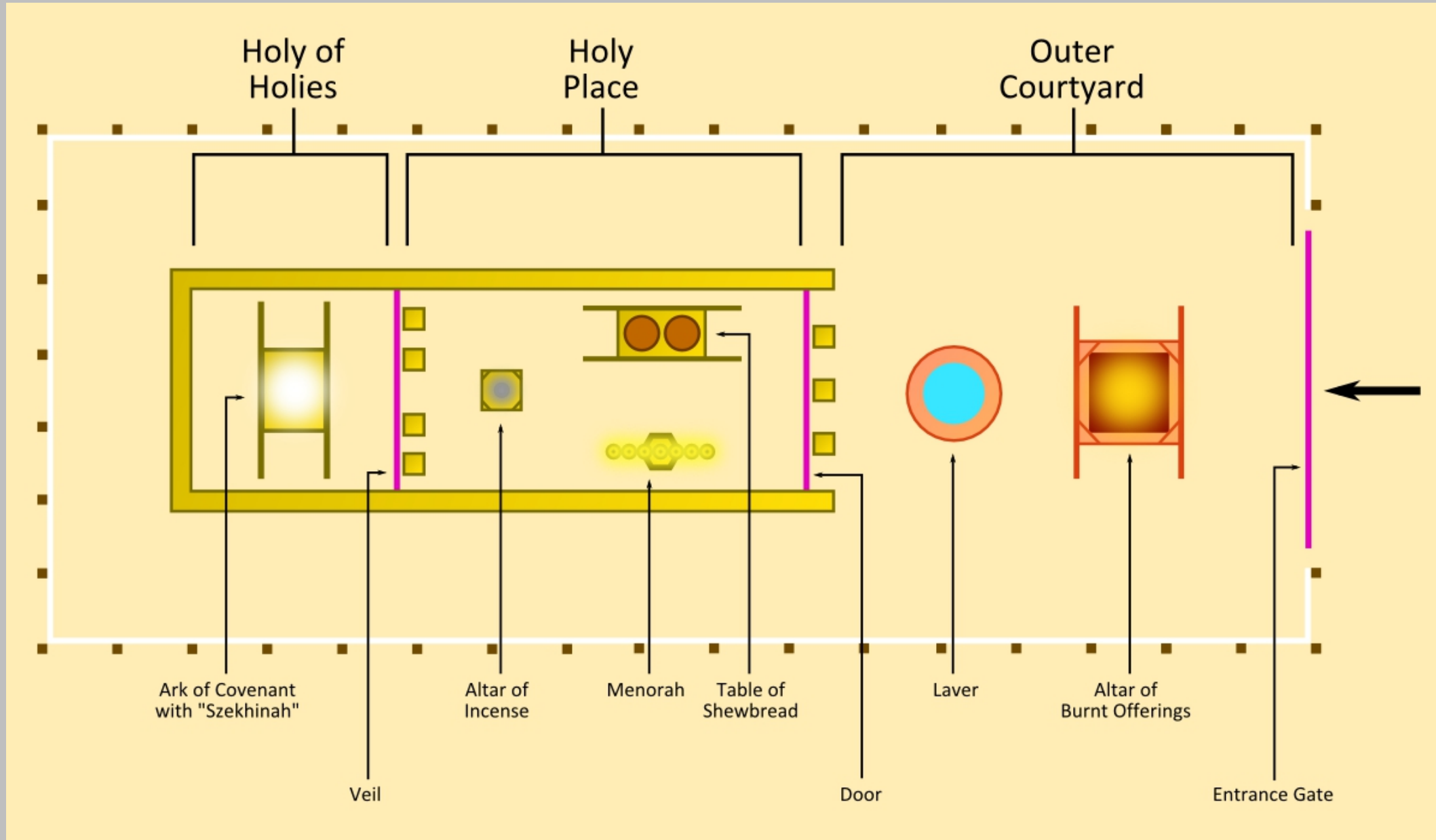
Wood overlaid with gold standing in front of the Veil to the Holy of Holies

Incense was burned on the altar

Prayers of the saints - (Revelation 5:8, 8:3-4)

Pray without ceasing – incense burns continuously – (1 Thessalonians 5:17)

Ark Size
1.15m long
0.7m wide
0.7m high

The Ark of the Covenant (Exodus 25:10-22)

Acacia wood, overlaid with gold carried by 2 long bars.

The ark - throne of God (Revelation 20:11)

The lid – mercy seat (Hebrews 4:16)

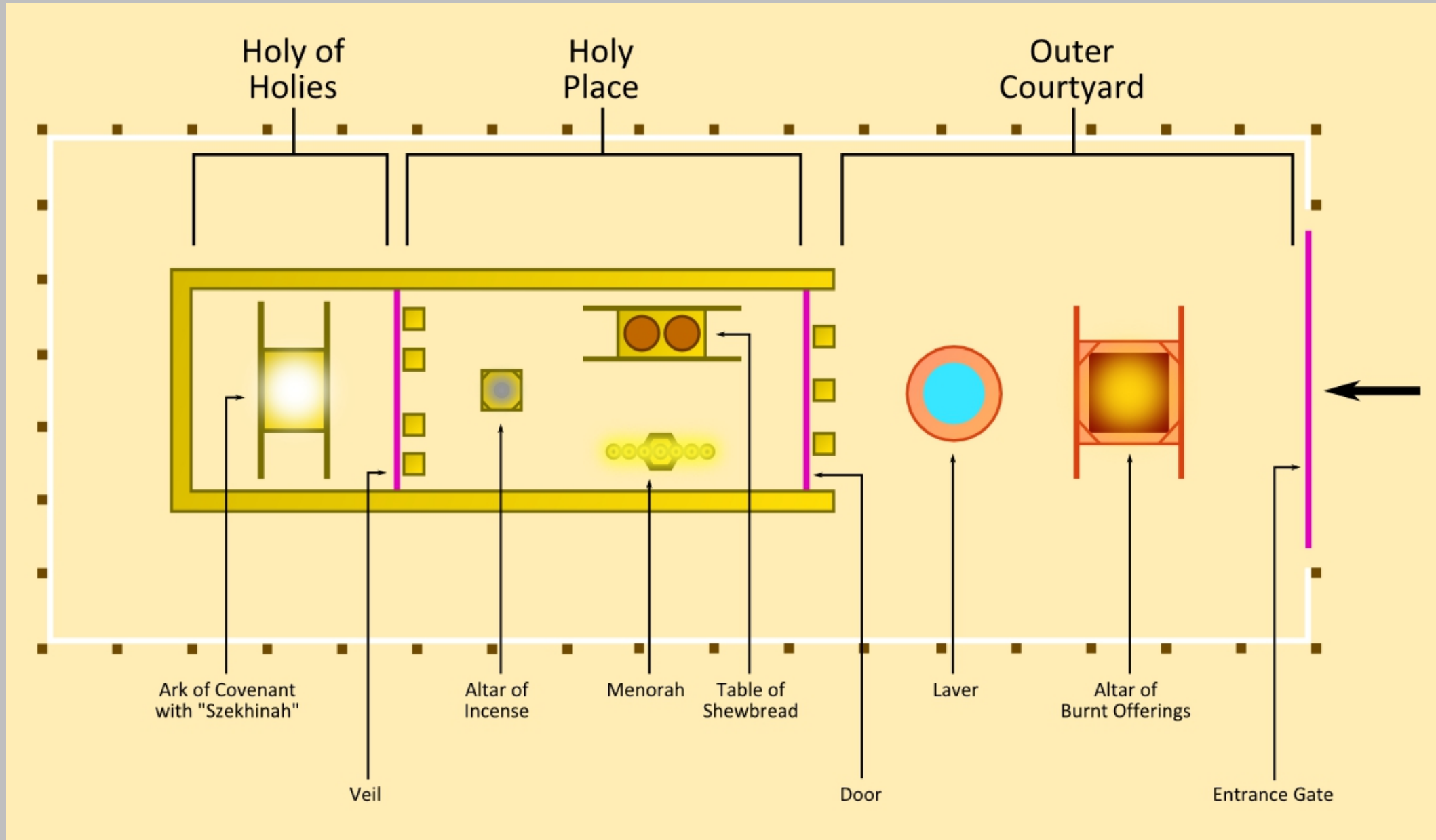
The Angels – covering (Ezekiel 28:14)

The Stone Tablets of the Law – The righteous standard of God (Romans 7:22)

Aaron's Rod that Budded – Resurrection and the life (John 11:25)

The Golden Pot of 'Hidden' Manna – Hidden in Christ (Colossians 3:3-4)

High Priest

Exodus 28 & 39

Aaron was the first high priest – Levite

White Robe – Righteousness and purity

Blue robe with pomegranates on the hem – Heavenly

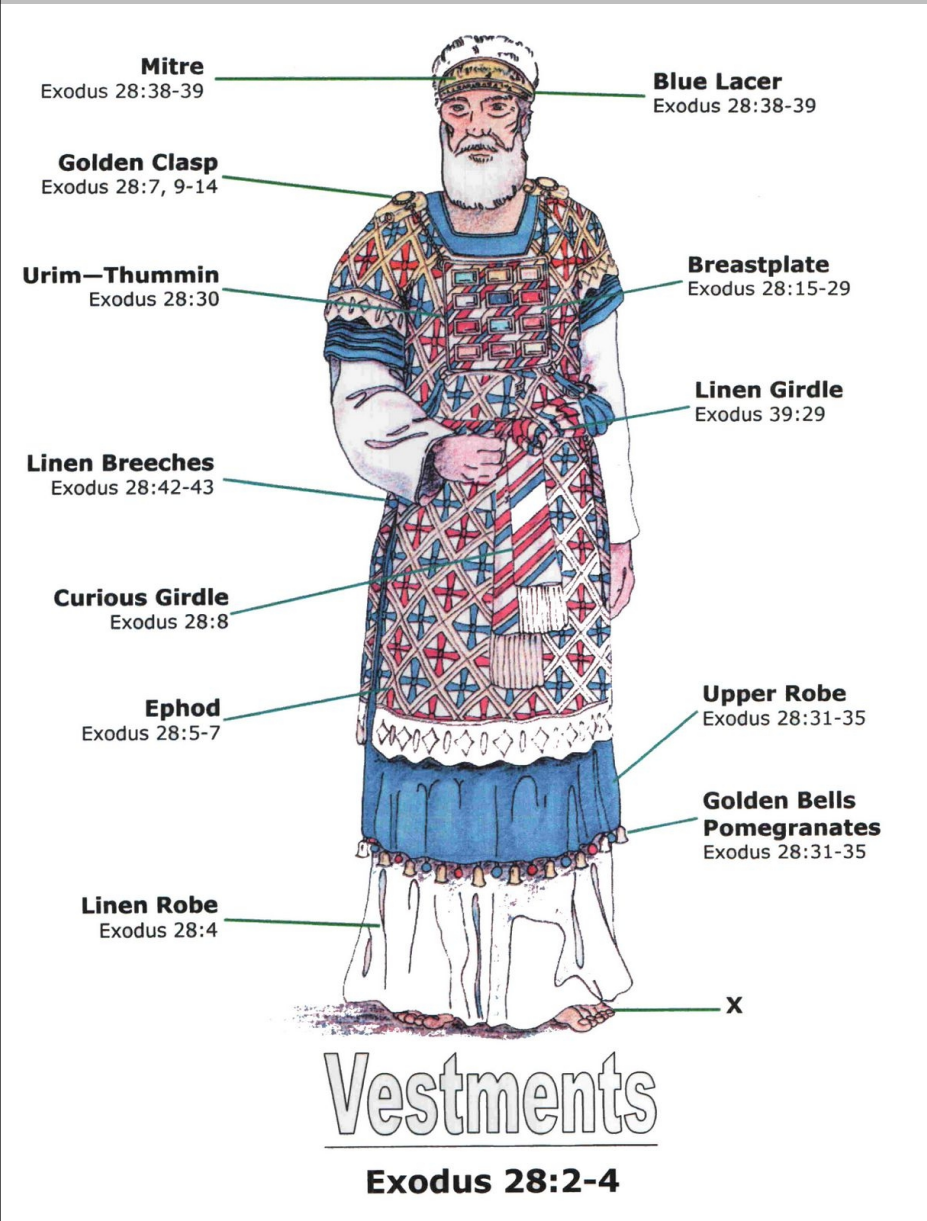
Gold, white, blue, red & purple ephod – Jesus (Hebrews 4:14 – 5:10)

On the shoulders, 2 precious stones with the 12 names of Israel.
Carries the burden (Luke 15:4-6, Isaiah 9:6)

Breast plate has 12 precious stones - Knows His sheep (John 3-4, 10:11-14)

Urim and Thummin were kept in the breastplate
2 Jewels meaning “lights” and “perfections”

White mitre with a gold hem with the words “Holy to the Lord” – King of righteousness (Hebrews 7:2)
