THE MINISTRY IN SOUTH SUDAN EXPANDS

Kennedy grew up in a refugee camp in Uganda, was born again there and felt a strong call in 2023 to return to his homeland and share Jesus with his countrymen. He has set up a simple farming operation to support the ministry. He has trained a team of men in the Apostolic vision as well as agriculture to support their ministry. This team has a vision to reach every province in their nation. They are also preaching in a refugee camp for displaced Sudanese, who are primarily muslim. The team are also setting up small businesses in Juba to generate income to support the church.

The nation and the region are in continual conflict, creating a very difficult environment to live in, yet in spite of these many challenges there are great opportunities for the gospel.

Pray for the team here to remain strong in their faith, to walk in God's grace and the power of the Holy Spirit and for God's provision as the ministry continues to expand..

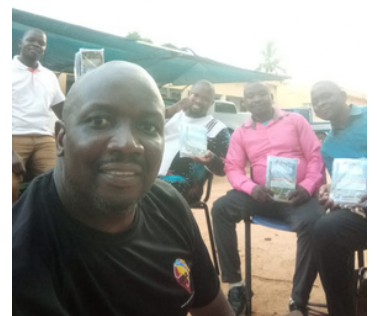

RWANDA

The church in Rwanda continues to struggle against the government’s rigid policies on churches and their highly regulated requirements for churches to function in the nation. It has taken the church 6 years to raise funds to purchase a suitable building and now construction is underway to meet the government’s regulations. Funds are required to bring it to this acceptable standard before they will be permitted to use the facility. Please pray for Gods provision and favor with the authorities.



ANGOLA

Abel and team are progressing well in this new ministry, the GFA network is expanding, and new provinces are opening up. Continue to pray for open doors, ministries to be raised up and a strong team who will reach the nation and beyond. This team are supporting the ministry in Namibia. Elias from Mozambique visited Namibia and Angola in February to encourage the churches.

CAMEROON

Brother Tobol is expanding the network within the region - CAR, Gabon and Congo. We pray for the right connections in these nations as the network expands.

GUINEA

Brother Cece has been doing evangelism crusades in rural areas in the interior of the country among mainly muslim communities. The response has been incredible as many have left islam and turned to Jesus. Pray for the discipling of these new converts and for strong churches to be established.



SOUTH AFRICA

We witnessed 22 people being baptized from the various churches. The network is growing slowly, we are seeing a growth in the young adult group. We held a youth conference “Living free in a sexual pandemic”. We had a wonderful attendance with youth committing their lives to Jesus and wanting to walk in sexual purity.



The GFA planning team spent 1 week together in Howick, planning for 2025. We are excited to be laboring together with Jesus and are expecting great things in 2025.
