KENYA

A very sucessful conference was held in Western Kenya at Lusengeli, Vihiga from 15-20 April.

The Pentecostal Gospel Church under the leadership team of Owen, Oscar and Ivan hosted this very well organized conference. There were well over 100 church leaders from the region with a total of around 500 people attending.

The theme for the conference was on leadership, the GFA team from Kenya(Reuben, Moses, Isaac, William), Tanzania (Rexmidas), Uganda(Mika, Deo), DRC(Espoire), Rwanda(Paul) & Burundi(Thierry) all participated in the ministry. We had an incredibly blessed time of ministry and fellowship, bonds were built and the vision for the continent was strongly established in the hearts of those attending.

SENEGAL

Elijah(Cote d' Ivoire) travelled to Kafountine from 14-19 April. Gospel For Africa took another bold step in spreading the Gospel and strengthening the Church across the continent. Kafountine is a predominantly Muslim town located in the southern region of Senegal. The journey from Dakar to Kafountine took 15 hours as it was necissary to pass through "The Gambia".

The purpose of this trip was twofold: A fraternal visit to local believers and the launch of an introductory seminar on the mission and vision of GFA. The "Church On The Rock" booklet was used to share the vision.

SEIRRA LEONE

Kamano(Guinea) traveled to Freetown to share the vision with church leaders.

Abioseh Pratt (founder of Full Gospel Evangelical Ministry) was the conference host, who took great care of us and organized a good conference. There were 63 attendees, the response to the vision was encouraging and there was a commitment from many to network together with GFA in the Nation. Pray for Abioseh and team as they expand the network in Seirra Leone. We trust the Lord for this gospel to permeate the entire nation.



UGANDA

Ezekiel, Cedric and Mika have conducted conferences in Nakivale and Kyaka. These are refugee camps with mainly DRC and South Sudanese.

80+ leaders attended and teaching was given on how to build the church, Godly character, Spiritual gifts and evangelism meetings were conducted in the evenings. The response was very good with many joining the GFA network.

They were very appreciative of the church on the rock books.



ETHIOPIA

Receive greetings from Arba Minch in Ethiopia. The city originated due to forty springs close to the city. It is full of kind and welcoming people. My visit to share the vision was a great blessing to the church. MOROCCO

We continue be amazed at what God is doing in this Islamic country, although illegal for Moroccans to be Christian and in the face of much persecution many are coming to faith in Christ. The number of Christians is increasing, God still revealing Himself to people through dreams and visions and many now being reached through social media. We continue praying for God to save many in this nation as well as other Islamic nations in North Africa who face persecution. We trust the Lord to take care, protect and provide for His children.

Many face rejection from family, loose employment or just cant get employment and are facing economic hardship, please pray for them to know God's grace.

SOUTH SUDAN

The training center in Yei is slowly being developed as are the agricultural projects which are supporting the ministry.

We trained many leaders through May and June(5 seminars) with the church on the rock books.

We have developed teams for reaching South Sudan and in June had training in Juba for all leaders. We are assisting leaders to start small business and agriculture projects to sustain the ministry in South Sudan and beyond.





MALAWI

Scott(South Africa) and Elias(Mozambique) travelled to Blantyre Malawi for a conference over the weekend of 6-8 June. We had about 50 leaders attend with a great response to the ministry. The country was well represented and a network has been established. Nixon from southern Malawi also has a network of churches in Mozambique and will connect them with Elias network. There is great enthusiasm regarding the vision and growing the ministry in the region.



GUINEA

Cece and team have being conducting various evangelism events in regions around Kissidougou. These are Muslim communities and many are turning to Christ. Pray for the team that God will give them boldness and grace as they continue to reach into these very difficult communities.



ANGOLA

Abel has been sharing the vision in various network churches in Namibe. The network continues to grow and churches are been established on the apostolic foundation. The GFA team in Namibe is growing and brothers are expanding into other regions.

A new church is currently being planted in Benguela, please pray for Abel and team as they establish the church here, it is about 500km from Namibe and halfway to Luanda. Abel has also made contact with a churches in Lubango and Luanda and is planning to expand the network there.
